What is the best time to visit Cordoba?

Each season has its own charm: spring offers the famous patios in bloom and pleasant temperatures. In summer, the patios and alleys provide a refreshing refuge from the heat. And both the autumn and winter are perfect for explore the city without crowds while you enjoy a magical and cozy atmosphere.

How can I avoid crowds at the Mosque?

Early morning (8:30-10:00) or late afternoon (17:00-19:00) are the quietest times. For a unique experience, consider the "The Soul of Cordoba" evening tour.

What areas are ideal for a leisurely stroll?

The Jewish quarter and the San Basilio neighborhood offer quiet alleys perfect for getting lost. The surroundings of the Guadalquivir Riverbank are ideal for leisurely sunsets.
